1986 POPULATION CENSUS: Census Night is the night of Sunday 31st August 1986. During the next ten days enumerators will visit every household in Fiji and record particulars of everyone who is in the house on census night. The law requires you to answer all questions on the census form except the question about religion, which is not compulsory. Members of our jamaat are advised to answer this question, thus:

Please ensure that you write the full name of your jamaat to avoid a possible mix up with the Qadiani members. The Government considers it essential to have with it the exact population strength of the various religious organisations in this country especially when it comes to making national decisions concerning these organisations. The allocation of the number of religious programmes each year to any one organisation depends on the organisation's membership roll.
