Hazrat Ameer's Ramadan Message

بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ الرَّحْمٰنِ الرَّحِيْمِ

Say: My prayer and my sacrifice and my life and my death are surely for Allah, the Lord of the worlds- No associate has He. And this am I commanded, and I am the first of those who submit. (6:163-4)

The Holy month of Ramadan is here and we are granted by Allah an opportunity to pray, fast and read the Quran at least one time and listen to it while its is being recited in the Tarawih prayers.

In this month will also fall the *blessed night of Laila tul Qadr*; the night in which the revelation of the Holy Qur'an started. This changed the darkness that prevailed spiritually in the world at the time to a light which was to enlighten the

entire world. The Quran was the final message to mankind revealed to Allah's last messenger, the Prophet Muhammad, may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, whose advent had been foretold by all the prophets and was awaited by all peoples through the ages.

Allah blessed this night and gave the month of Ramadan a special eminence. It was stated in the Qur'an that:

The Night of Majesty is better than a thousand months.

97:3

Thousand months is just over 83 years; which is a good age for a person to live. Thus the verse states that the prayers that one seeks in this *blessed night* if answered will be more in worth than a life time of toil for the livelihood in this worldly life. It

thus draws our attention to the futility of this worldly life and to the main objective of our creation - nearness to the Creator. This is attained by purification of the soul through prayers and fasting. In both prayer and fasting one gets an opportunity to beseech the Creator in unison with the whole Muslim Umma.

The oneness in devotional acts of Islam, be they, the Pilgrimage, the Fasting or the Prayers is the outward manifestation of the belief in the Oneness of Allah Himself.

The Jalsa may appear to the uncanny eye as a normal meeting but it was charged with the electricity of deep emotion, firm conviction and it was

crowned with showers of divine blessings. The challenges in the world are no doubt ever increasing and so also are our abilities to deal with those challenges.

Hazrat Ameer's Ramadan ul Mubarak Message

In the name of Allah, the Beneficent, the Merciful

“O you who believe fasting is prescribed for you as it was prescribed for those before you, so that you may guard against evil.” (Al-Baqarah 2:183)

“And when My servants ask thee concerning Me, surely I am nigh. I answer the prayer of the suppliant when he calls on Me, so they should hear My call and believe in Me that they may walk in the right way” (Al-Baqarah 2:186)

Dear Sisters and Brothers,
Assalaam-o-Alaikum Wa Rakhmatullahi Wa Barakaato Hoo.

This year I have selected two verses from Surah Al-Baqarah (The Cow) for my Ramadan message. As we all look forward to this Blessed Month we should reflect on these verses as the first one gives us the reason for fasting and the second the path to nearness to Allah.

The major reason given for fasting in the Holy Qur'an is that 'you may guard against evil' i.e. to attain Taqwah. Taqwah may be understood to represent the spirit (baatin) of an outwardly act (zaahir). As stated in the Holy Qur'an this is the main aim of all devotional acts in Islam and other major religions. This is what the Prophet Muhammad, may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, meant when he said that it is not your thirst and hunger that pleases Allah but the Taqwah; this is also what is mentioned in the Bible where Mathew 6: 16-18 states:

“Moreover when ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces, that they may appear unto men to fast. Verily I say unto you, they have their reward.

But thou, when thou fastest, anoint thy head, and wash thy face; That thou appear not unto men to fast, but unto thy Father which is in

secret: and thy Father, which seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly.”

The main advantage of Taqwah which is stated in verse 186 is that one is able to attain nearness to Allah. This verse also gives us guidance on how this nearness is attained. What we have to do is to believe in Him and hear His call by being obedient and submitting completely to Him (i.e. becoming His abd).

Allah desires that human beings seek closeness to Him; He assures that He is close to those who are His abd. Though translated as 'servants' abd in the real sense means people who mould their lives in such a way that they live as Allah wishes them to; spend their lives as exemplified by the Holy Prophet Muhammad, may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him.

Dear Sisters and Brothers, I pray that Allah grants us the opportunity to attain nearness to Him by following the guidance in the Holy Qur'an, the revelation of which commenced in this Blessed Month. I pray that we fast with the aim of elevating our 'baatin' so we attain the state where we feel His presence in our hearts. I pray that He accepts our prayers and devotional acts ('ibaadat) during this sacred month.

As you pray for members of your families and dear ones, don't forget that you are members of a bigger family, our Jama'at. Pay particular attention to your brothers and sisters of the Jama'at in your prayers. You have also to pray for the Muslims of the world and Islam which is passing through time of great trials and tribulations; you have

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The Essence of Du'a.

Du'a is not just the mumbling of a few words, for this amounts to nothing whatsoever.

The true meaning of du'a is to beseech Allah, Most High, sincerely for His assistance. This petition becomes perfect and efficacious only when man surrenders his all to Allah, Most High, with total anguish of heart, perturbation and heart-burning and makes supplication so fervently that his soul melts like water and flows at the threshold of Divine Unity.

For example, look at how a person who is embroiled in a misfortune importunes people for help in moving terms and see what a wonderful change and transformation his appeal undergoes – the tone of his voice becomes full of anguish which attracts the mercy of people.

Similarly, when a person makes du'a to Allah, Most High, the tone of his voice changes also and is filled with tenderness and pain that causes the fountain of Divinity to gush forth with mercy. When du'a is being made the modulation of one's voice should be such that every limb of the body is affected and meekness and humility issue from the tongue. The

heart must also be filled with softness and agony and the limbs must surrender with total submission to the Creator.

Over and above all this, one must have complete faith in Allah's mercy and generosity and entertain complete hope of acceptance of one's entreaty. If one should fall at the Divine threshold in such a state he will never be disappointed and in this condition he should beseech the Almighty over and over in the following manner:

"Dear Master, I am nothing but a weak, helpless sinner. Without Your support and mercy I can never amount to anything. Please have pity on me and cleanse me of my sins for without Your kindness and grace there is no one else who can purify me."

When a person makes this kind of petition repeatedly and continuously and seeks Allah's assistance with patience and perseverance then at some unforeseen time a light will descend from Allah, Most High, and peace will suffuse the heart of the suppliant

and thus the darkness which formerly covered his heart will be dispelled.

Allah, Most High, will then endow him with a power that creates a revolution in his heart for sins from which he will be saved. At this point he will realise that his heart which had become seized and imprisoned in low passions and carnal desires as if hundreds of thousands of chains had fettered him and were drawing him helplessly towards a life of sinfulness – at this stage he will find that these chains have been miraculously cut in a flash and he has been liberated.

His former love for sin will be replaced by hatred for it and instead of fear and hatred for Allah, Most High, love for Him and a magnetic attraction in his heart for his Lord will be born as the Holy Qur'an delineates in 49:7-8:

"...but Allah has endeared the faith to you and has made it seemly in your hearts, and He has made hateful to you disbelief and transgression and disobedience. Such are those who are rightly guided —A grace from Allah and a favour."
